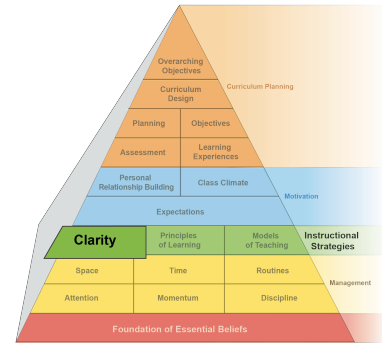

### Mastery Objectives...

1. Begin with the learner as subject
2. Use active performance verbs
3. Use language that indicates development of capacity
4. Avoid mental action words
5. Are stated in kid-friendly language
6. Link to appropriate curriculum standards
7. Are worth knowing
8. Match to students in challenge and attainability

### Statement of Mastery Objective

#### “Not Yet” Mastery Objective:

Students will review the classifications of rocks for a test.

#### Revised Mastery Objective:

Students will be able to *classify* rock samples accurately into the three categories of igneous, metamorphic, and sedimentary.

#### Better Mastery Objective:
